



The IOSH Working Safely Course has been developed by the Institution of Occupational Safety and Health to address the general aspects of health and safety at work for a wide range of personnel. It is a course for staff from any sector with no supervisory or managerial responsibility.

↳ Benefits of Attending

Successful completion leads to the award of the nationally recognised IOSH certificate or passport card.

Delegates will have a good understanding of the key elements of working safely and how they can ensure the safety and health of themselves as well as others.

↳ Course Structure

The course provides a grounding in the essentials of health and safety – everyone at work should have an understanding of why they must ‘work safely’ and this course delivers this.

It is divided into five modules:

1. Introducing Working Safety
2. Defining Hazard and Risk
3. Identifying Common Hazards
4. Improving Safety Performance
5. Protecting our Environment

The delegates are assessed at the end of the course by a multiple choice written assessment and a project completed at their workplace.
