↳ Course Structure

The qualification is split into four modules:

Module A: Managing Health and Safety

Module B: Hazardous Agents in the Workplace

Module C: Workplace and Workplace Equipment

Module D: Application of Health and Safety Theory and Practice (assignment based)

Modules A, B and C are assessed by a written three hour examination.

Module D is an 8,000 word assignment.

Candidates may choose to take individual modules in any order over a five year period from registration.





Duration

Module A: 17 days

Module B: 10 days

Module C: 11 days

2 days revision per module.

The course is run on a day release basis (i.e. one day per week) over an eighteen month period. Exams are in January and July.

Entry Requirements

There are no formal entry requirements; however the syllabus assumes a broad basic knowledge of health and safety. The achievement of the Nebosh General Certificate or direct equivalent prior to undertaking the Diploma course is highly recommended.
